

## DO NOT BURN TREATED WOOD OFF-CUTS OR DISPOSED OF TREATED TIMBER

The burning of CCA treated timber carries a high risk of harming the environment due to the release of airborne chromium and arsenic compounds. These toxic chemicals can be inhaled and transferred to any food that is being cooked over a fire with burning CCA timber.

Ash formed through the combustion of CCA contains extremely high concentrations of arsenic and chromium. This contaminated ash can cause a health risk to humans; contaminate the soil and contaminate underground water. Contaminated ash can deem the land unsuitable for agricultural use due to the salty taste making it attractive to livestock, presenting a health risk to the livestock.

## **BURNING OF CCA TREATED TIMBER IS PROHIBITED!!**

Rather burn untreated wood off-cuts and disposed of wood to create a healthier and safe environment.
